This means that you must live in the PHM district to sign-up for our Penn "Senior" Basketball League. The "Senior" league is going to follow a different format this season. The first hour will be a league game and the second hour will be a practice facilitated by the Lady Kingsmen Basketball High School staff with assistance from the team coach.

The league has attained a rental agreement that will allow practices and games to be held in school facilities within the Penn-Harris-Madison district. The "Senior" league will begin on September $11^{\text {th }}$ and will end on November $20^{\text {th }}$ with an all day shootout.

All games will be played on Sundays at Penn High School in the main, auxiliary and fitness center courts. Game Times are:

Both practice days will occur during the specified grade level times above. Games will begin on September $25^{\text {th }}$. The cost of the league is $\$ 125.00$ per athlete for $7^{\text {th }}-8^{\text {th }}$ grade. The coaching staff will be made up of interested parents and community members. This league has assisted in developing and maintaining a winning tradition for the Lady Kingsmen Basketball program. It has also helped to develop numerous all NIC conference players, Indiana All-Stars, All-State players and collegiate basketball players.

If you are a hard worker and a team player, we invite you to join the Penn Community Junior Girls Basketball family and be a part of a winning tradition. If interested please sign-up on August $28^{\text {th }}$ in the Penn Arena from 12:00 to 2:00 pm. Registration form is on the back of this letter. Registering on time is essential to the organization of the league. A late fee of $\$ 10.00$ will be assessed for signing up after August $28^{\text {th }}$. No sign-ups will be accepted after Friday, September $2^{\text {nd }}$. No refunds will be given after league begins.

Bring the application form, check (made payable to Penn Basketball) and your daughter. There will be an athletic representative available if you wish to order basketball shoes, jersey, shirts, shorts, etc. All players need to have a Penn Jersey - this is the only required item you need to purchase if you do not already have one. Please be sure to carefully read all detailed information regarding important dates and times. All parents/guardians will be required to sign a liability waiver and a parent/guardian code of conduct. Players will not be allowed to participate once league games begin, if these forms are not completed.
